Civilization Effort on Bull Leg Operation by Karuna Club

The Laureate Institute of Pharmacy students witnessed a bull in the nearby village on July 27, 2024, with a wire tied around his leg. With the wire, a deep cut is made on his leg. The Laureate Institute of Pharmacy's Karuna Club is then notified by the students. The team members are then scheduled for this task and a meeting with the principal is scheduled for the same time. The bull is rescued by students, members of the Kuna Club, and local sympathizers. The operation takes two hours to complete. We succeeded after two hours, and the cable was cut off. The bull was given injections of various antibiotics or painkillers once the wire was removed. Povidone solution and regular saline solution are used to clean the entire wound. Flumetic WS spray and D mag spray are applied to the wound throughout the course of the following seven days.
