Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>As per the guidelines of Himachal Pradesh Technical University, Institute was committed to accomplish every academic task through online mode . All online assignment details and attendance of the students were uploaded regularly in university ERP portal- www.erp.himtu.ac.in</p> <p>Various ICT tools were used and many new online platforms were explored by the faculty members. Lectures and tutorials were conducted through zoom app, google meet and google classroom and college strictly followed the timetable and credit hour set by the Pharmacy council of India even in pandemic era.</p> <p>Faculty uploaded the important lectures and practical's on their individual YouTube channels and the links were shared on respective what's app groups. Regular assignments were given to the students by the faculty and collected through the Gmail and what's app. Besides , common platform, faculty also utilized gnomio platform and university ERP for smooth conduction of academic activities. Online quizzes were also conducted by using various platform like mentee, Google form etc. Institute purchased the subscription of the zoom app for smooth communication with the students and faculty. To address the issues of books and research article, EBSCO information services facilities were provided to student by sharing the username and password so that they were not devoid of study materials when they were at the home and teacher shared their notes and ppt through mail and what's app . Online classes were conducted by faculty in interactive mode.</p> <p>The class counselor and class coordinator were in constant touch with the students and parents at regular intervals and try to address the problems they faced during online classes. As our college is located in a rural and hilly area, students who faced network issues were given special priorities by the faculty through telephonic conversation to rectify their doubts. Faculty meetings were conducted regularly through college zoom account. Principal and Dean academics provided university instructions, guidance's to the faculty which helped them to complete the syllabus on time. Other issues such as student records maintaining and problems faced by the teacher during online classes were discussed, addressed, and rectified.</p>
