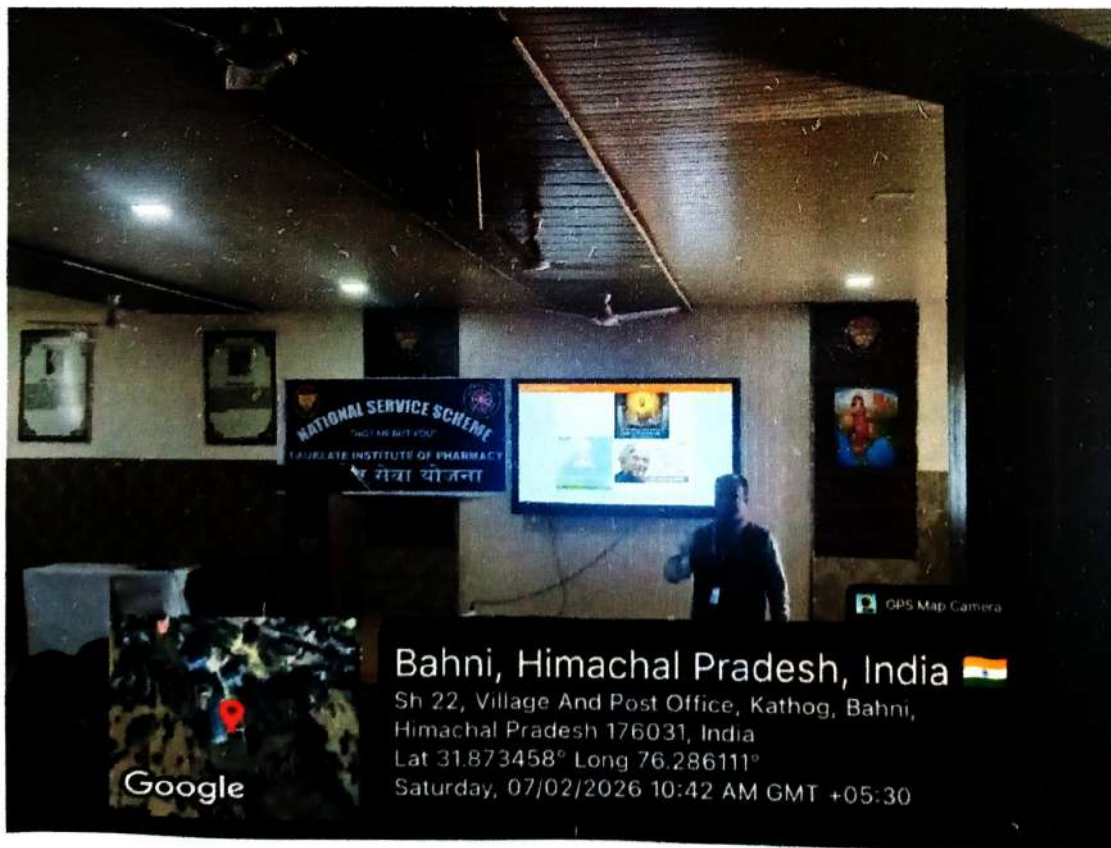
Report on Pharmacy Awareness Session

A Pharmacy Awareness Session was successfully organized on 7th February 2026 by the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Laureate Institute of Pharmacy. The session was conducted for the students of Class 10th and 11th and faculty members of Government Senior Secondary School (GSSS) Bilaspur, Haripur, Distt Kangra. The program aimed to create awareness about pharmacy education, career opportunities, and the role of pharmacists in healthcare and society.

Objectives of the Session

The primary objectives of the awareness session were:

- To introduce students to the field of pharmacy and its importance in healthcare.
- To explain different pharmacy courses such as D.Pharm, B.Pharm, M.Pharm and Pharm. D.
- To highlight career opportunities in industry, hospitals, research, regulatory affairs, and entrepreneurship.
- To motivate school students to consider pharmacy as a professional career.
- To promote innovation, research, and societal responsibility among future aspirants.



The program began with a brief welcome address by the coordinators from Laureate Institute of Pharmacy. Resource persons explained the scope of pharmacy education, admission eligibility, course duration, and prospects. Emphasis was laid on the role of pharmacists in drug development, quality control, clinical pharmacy, public health, and regulatory affairs.

The NSS unit discussed innovation, start-ups, and entrepreneurship opportunities in pharmacy, encouraging students to think creatively and develop problem-solving skills. They highlighted the social responsibilities of pharmacists and the importance of community service, healthcare awareness, and ethical practices.
