MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

For Utilization of Research Centre Facilities

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is made and entered into on this day 24th day of May, 2026, by and between:

Shiva Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital (SAMCH), having its registered office at P.O Chandpur, district Bilaspur, H.P, herein after referred to as "SAMCH",

AND

** Laureate Institute of Pharmacy ** situated at Village and P.O. Kathog, Tehsil Jawalamukhi, Distt. Kangra, Himachal Pradesh, India, hereinafter referred to as "LIP".

Both institutions shall collectively be referred to as the "Parties".

1. PREAMBLE

Whereas SAMCH is engaged in Ayurvedic medical education, clinical services, and healthcare research; and

Whereas LIP possesses advanced research infrastructure, laboratories, instrumentation facilities, and expertise through its Research Centre;

Both Parties, recognizing the mutual benefits of academic and scientific cooperation, hereby agree to collaborate for the utilization of the Research Centre facilities of LIP by SAMCH for research, academic, and innovation-related activities.



2. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this MoU are to:

1. Facilitate access to the Research Centre and laboratory facilities of LIP for faculty members, researchers, postgraduate scholars, and students of SAMCH.
2. Promote collaborative and interdisciplinary research activities.
3. Strengthen research capacity in Ayurveda and allied sciences.
4. Encourage scientific innovation, analytical studies, and evidence-based research.
5. Facilitate training and skill development in advanced research methodologies and instrumentation.

3. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

Under this MoU, LIP may permit SAMCH to utilize the following facilities subject to availability and institutional norms:

- * Research laboratories and analytical facilities.
- * Instrumentation and testing facilities.
- * Central research equipment and allied infrastructure.
- * Technical and scientific guidance from LIP faculty/research personnel.
- * Training programs related to research methodology and laboratory practices.
- * Joint research projects, publications, and innovation initiatives.

The exact facilities, schedules, and operational modalities shall be mutually decided from time to time.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF LAUREATE INSTITUTE OF PHARMACY

LIP shall:

1. Provide access to designated research facilities and equipment as per mutually agreed schedules.
2. Facilitate technical support and guidance for research activities wherever feasible.
3. Ensure proper operational support for laboratory usage.
4. Nominate a coordinator for effective implementation and coordination of activities under this MoU.
5. Inform SAMCH regarding laboratory protocols, safety standards, and usage policies.



5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF SHIVA AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL

SAMCH shall:

1. Ensure that its faculty members, students, and researchers comply with the rules and regulations of LIP while using the facilities.
2. Use the research facilities strictly for academic and research purposes.
3. Bear the applicable user charges, consumable costs, testing fees, or other agreed expenses, wherever applicable.
4. Ensure proper handling of instruments, samples, and laboratory resources.
5. Nominate a nodal officer/coordinator for communication and coordination with LIP.

6. FINANCIAL TERMS

1. The use of research facilities may be subject to user charges and consumable costs as determined by LIP from time to time.
2. Specific financial arrangements for individual projects or facility usage shall be mutually agreed upon separately in writing.
3. Each Party shall bear its own administrative and operational expenses unless otherwise agreed.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

1. Intellectual Property Rights arising from collaborative research undertaken under this MoU shall be jointly discussed and governed through separate agreements.
2. Publications, patents, or scientific outputs resulting from collaborative work shall appropriately acknowledge both institutions.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY

Both Parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding research data, technical information, and proprietary knowledge shared during the course of collaboration, unless disclosure is required by law or mutually agreed upon.

9. DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This MoU shall remain valid for a period of ****Five (5) years**** from the date of execution.
2. The MoU may be renewed with mutual written consent.
3. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving three (3) months' prior written notice to the other Party.
4. Ongoing research activities initiated before termination may continue till their completion, subject to mutual agreement.



10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute arising out of the implementation or interpretation of this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation between the Parties.

11. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. This MoU serves as a framework for collaboration and does not create any legal partnership or employment relationship.
- 2. Amendments or modifications to this MoU shall be made only in writing and signed by both Parties.
- 3. Both Parties shall comply with applicable laws, institutional regulations, and ethical guidelines.

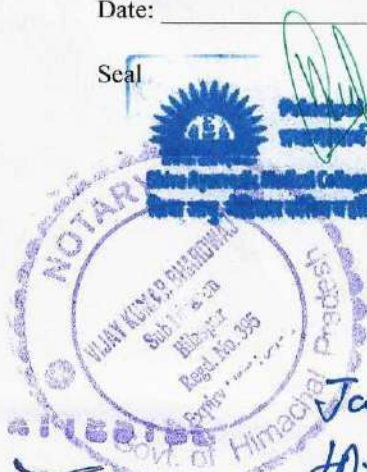
