Objectives:

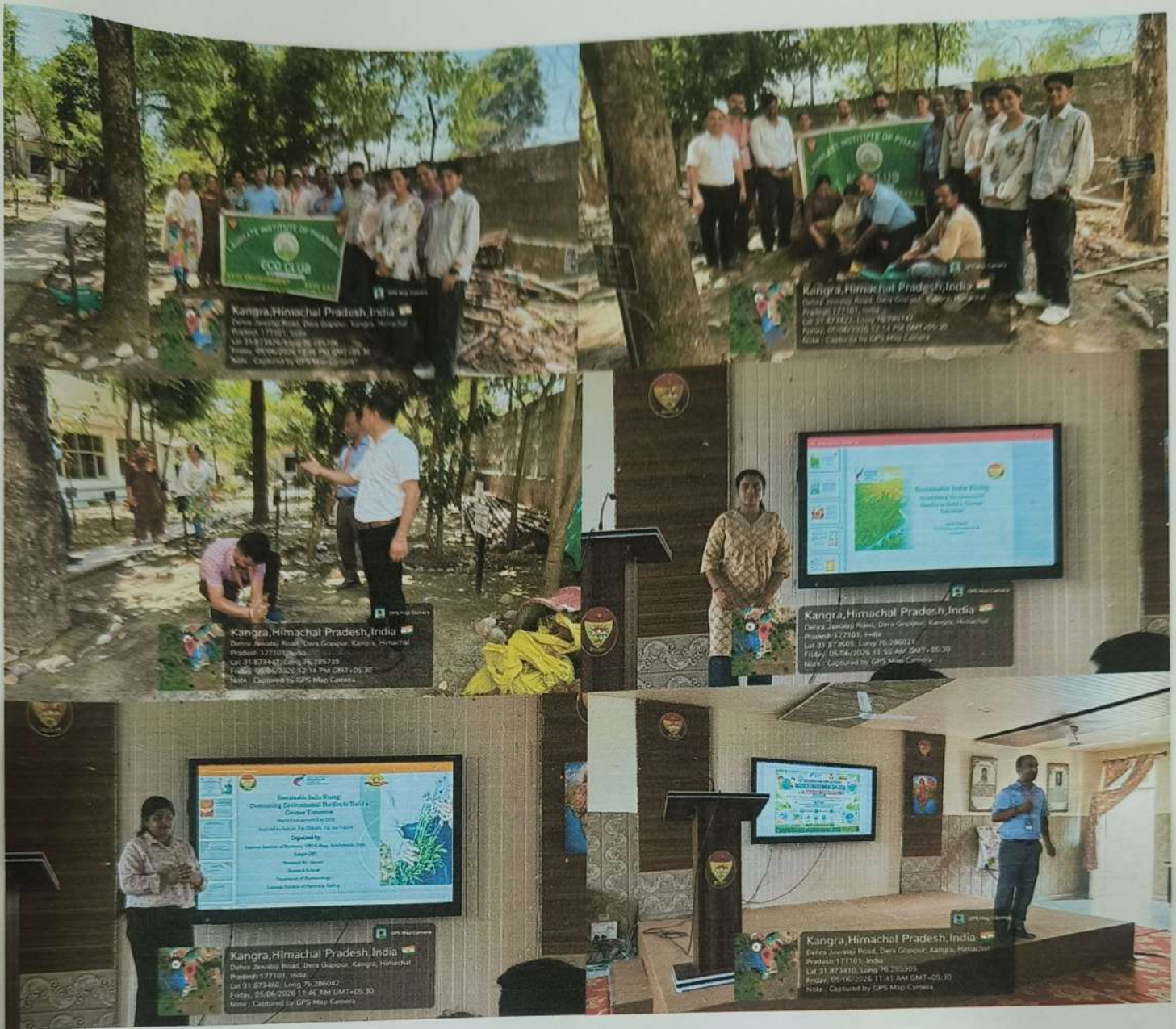
- To celebrate World Environment Day and promote environmental awareness.
